**NVIC celebrates its 40th birthday**



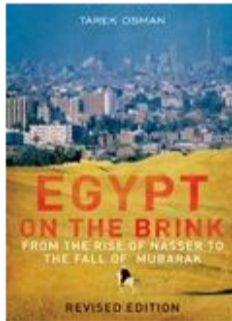
