In a speech delivered on the 26th of November 1940—75 years ago—Prof. Cleveringa spoke out against the *Berufsverbot* issued against his Jewish colleagues by the German occupiers. We are proud to announce that Prof. dr. Olaf Kaper will deliver this year's Cleveringa Lecture titled "The Oases of the Western Desert during the Libyan Wars of the New Kingdom". A seminar on the "Lybians in Ancient Egypt" is held on the same day, and brings together some of the finest specialists in archeology and Egyptology.
