## Internship in Greenpeace International's Legal Unit

Legal internships are available with the Legal Unit of Greenpeace International. The Legal Unit (four staff, including two *advocaten*, a solicitor and a para-legal) advises Greenpeace International, and when necessary the national and regional offices of Greenpeace, on campaigns and organisational legal issues and provides support with legal cases.

Alongside the daily practice of the Legal Unit there are various research projects that, in accordance with the specific interests and background of the intern, can be undertaken.

Legal internships are full-time positions (40 hours per week) for a period of two months. Remuneration is by a modest monthly contribution towards cost of living (i.e. € 400 per month for Dutch residents, € 800 per month for foreign residents).

### Essential Skills / Qualifications:

- Law student towards end of studies or recent law graduate
- For Dutch law students: background in *Nederlands recht* and/or *Internationaal recht*
- For foreign law students: strong background in International (Environmental) Law
- Fluent in written and spoken English.

Strong analytical skills

Self-confident, focused, pro-active and result oriented

Self-motivated team player with proactive "get the job done" mentality

Flexible attitude to shifting work priorities

Applications must be in English, and consist of a single e-mail (quoting Internship-Legal Unit-GPI in the email subject) that includes both your cover letter and c.v. as attachments and/or contained in the body of the e-mail. Applications will not be accepted without all of the following indicated information included in your e-mail:

- i) detailed cover letter indicating why your skill-sets/experience make you a strong candidate, and your personal motivation for undertaking a Legal Unit internship with Greenpeace International;
- ii) detailed c.v., including academic achievement, work and volunteer experience and English fluency;
- iii) detailed indication of your grade-point-average upon graduation for each of your university degrees (original university transcripts not necessary) or of your grades to date;
- iv) indicate nationality - Please note that you must have a student and/or work and/or residency permit for the Netherlands;
- v) Please indicate which period you would be available for the internship.
