

## **Internship Applied Cognitive Psychology**

The aim of this module is to exchange information about the internship possibilities and requirements. Students can find information about, among other things, institutions that may offer internships (see below). Participants in this module include students who are registered for the one-year Applied Cognitive Psychology Master course and the teachers (instructors). Teachers can add information, communications, etc. (for example about a new institute offering internships).

In Course Documents there are forms related to the internship: the internship contract and evaluation forms.

Messages and requests will regularly be posted from institutes and companies offering a student internship (and possibly a thesis).

## **Internal supervision**

It is in all cases advisable for students to make an agreement with a teacher about the supervision of the internship.
