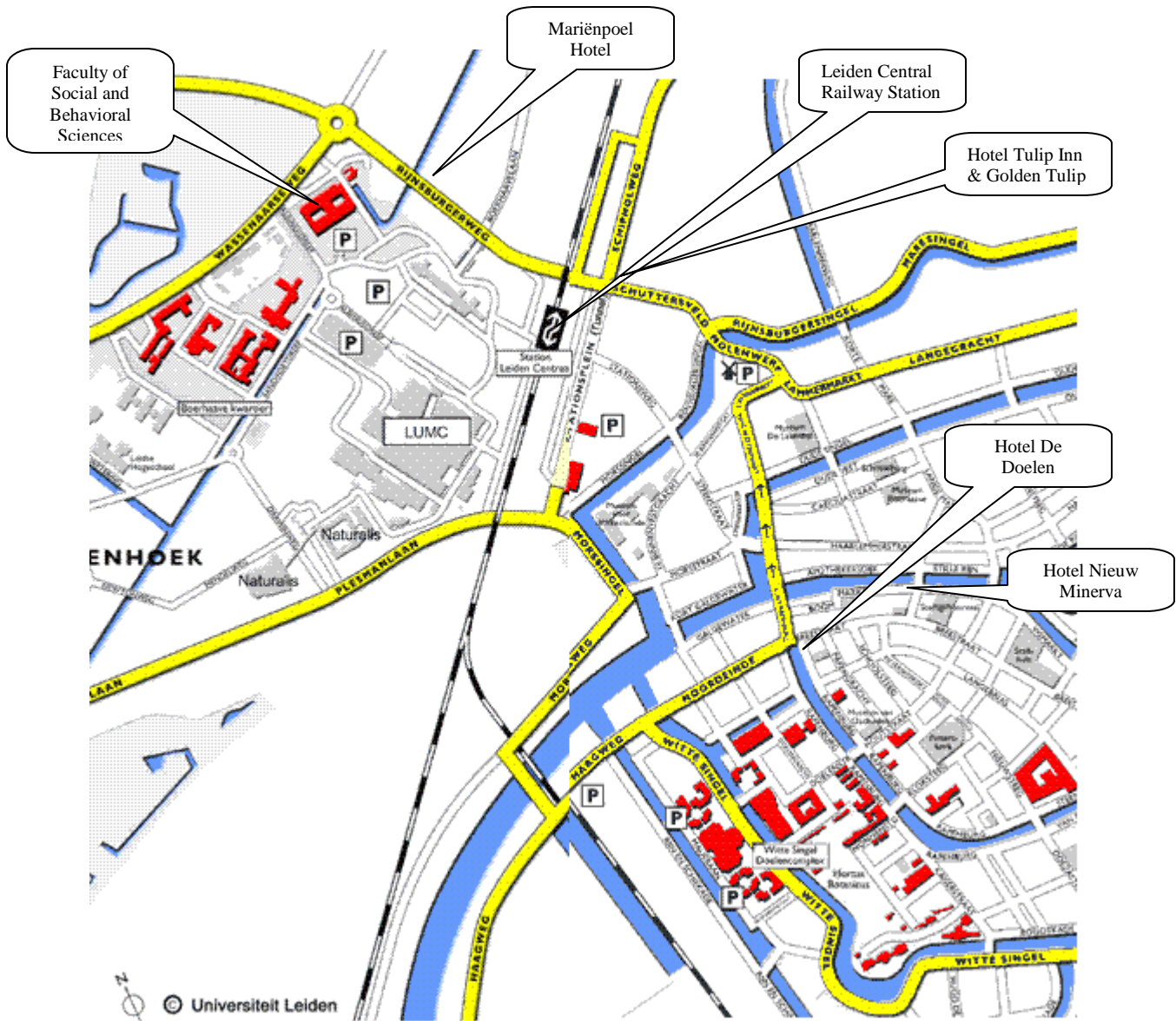


## Route description to Leiden and the Centre for Child and Family Studies



### TO LEIDEN FROM SCHIPHOL AIRPORT

#### By public transportation

From Schiphol Airport it takes about 15 minutes by train to **Leiden Central Station**. Trains in the direction of *Dordrecht* or *Den Haag CS* leave about every 15 minutes and stop at Leiden CS. A train ticket can be purchased at one of the ticket offices in the main hall at the exit of Schiphol Airport and costs approx. 5 euros (one way ticket, second-class ticket).

### **By taxi**

It is possible to take a taxi to Leiden from Schiphol Airport. Tariffs range from 40 to 100 euros, depending on the cab company and whether you travel during the day or at night (at night one pays double the normal rate). More information can be found at <http://www.schiphol.com/>.

Take the north-west exit of Leiden Central Railway Station to the Academic hospital (Leids Universitair Medisch Centrum on the map), instead of the City exit. Cross the square and the street right in front of you. Continue walking straight ahead and you will see a large yellow building. This is the Pieter de la Court Building which is where the Faculty of Social and Behavioral Sciences is resident. The Centre for Child and Family Studies is located at the third floor.
