LICENCE AGREEMENT FOR NON-EXCLUSIVE PUBLICATION OF DISSERTATION IN DIGITAL FORM

- having regard to article 19 of the Leiden University PhD Regulation 2008

The PhD candidate:

- gives Leiden University permission to make his/her dissertation available worldwide in digital form. This permission is non-exclusive;
- gives Leiden University permission to convert his/her dissertation into another file format or to another medium for the purpose of guaranteeing future accessibility, the foregoing without incurring any alteration to the content;
- gives Leiden University permission to make one or more reserve copies of this dissertation and to retain this with a view to security and to preservation of the files;
- declares that this dissertation is his/her own work;
- declares that the electronic and printed versions are identical in terms of content. All images (photos, tables, etc.) which are in the printed version are also integral to the electronic version;
- declares also that to the best of his/her knowledge, the dissertation does not breach the intellectual property rights of others;

- declares that he/she in the event of transfer to any third party of his/her intellectual property rights pertaining to the dissertation will stipulate that this third party should maintain the licence and should take over this licence;
 - grants the current licence for an indefinite period;
 - declares he/she waives the right to terminate this licence by means of cancellation or annulment;
