#### **Directions - Public Transport**

As LUC's new building is right behind The Hague Central Station it is easiest to travel by public transport. If you enter the station from the front entrance, you continue to walk straight ahead to Platform 12, keeping the Platforms on your right-hand side. Go through the exit beyond Platform 12, and you will immediately see the LUC building and its front entrance.

### **Directions - Traveling by Car**

- From Amsterdam via the A4 to the *Prins Clausplein*.
- From Rotterdam via the A13, then the A4 to the *Prins Clausplein*.
- From Utrecht via the A12 then the A13 to the *Prins Clausplein*.

### From the *Prins Clausplein*:

Follow the signs Den Haag over the Utrechtse Baan. At the end of the motorway, turn left onto the Zuid-Hollandlaan. Make sure the Malieveld remains on your left hand side. Continue towards The Hague central station and turn left towards the Q-Park CS-New Babylon for parking.

# **Parking**

Parking (paid) is possible at the <u>Q-Park CS - New Babylon</u> (Prinses Irenestraat 1, 2595 BD The Hague), which is situated right in between New Babylon and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and is at a one-minute walking distance from LUC The Hague.
