


Leiden University Wireless Access

	<p>This location offers two routes for wireless access to internet using hardware which allows for wireless internet access on the basis of WIFI. This means you can use any of the following devices: a notebook (Windows, Apple, LINUX), but also a PDA or smartphone (equipped with Windows Pocket PC).</p> <p>The difference between access via Leiden University and access via Eduroam lies in the degree of security and the complexity of the initial (one-off) installation or configuration of the access programme. These differences are further explained below.</p>

<p>What requirements must my notebook, pda or smartphone meet?</p>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Up-to-date antivirus software. 2. The latest (security) updates for your operating system.
<p>Which account do I use to gain access?</p>	<p>Students and staff members of Leiden University can log in using their ULCN account (which is also the same as their Eduroam account). Staff members and students of other universities and universities of professional education can log in using their Eduroam account.</p>
<p>Can I use my notebook to access the university remote work place ?</p>	<p>Staff members can access Remote VUW via http://remotewp.vuw.leidenuniv.nl</p>
<p>Can I use the wireless network access to print?</p>	<p>Staff members can print on the printers at their work place via Remote VUW. Manuals for wireless printing can be found at wireless.leidenuniv.nl ("Handleidingen wireless access")</p>

Eduroam

<p>Leiden University offers you a non-secure Internet connection (data traffic is not encrypted). For this reason, access to external websites is more limited than with Eduroam. You can log in directly through the LUWA website. This allows you to get started quickly!</p>	<p>Eduroam offers you a secure Internet connection and all data traffic is encrypted. However, the first time you make use of this option, you must first download the Eduroam software. This is a slightly more time-consuming operation. The advantage is that you can also use this Client to log in to the wireless network of other universities.</p> <p>In addition, there are no access restrictions for external websites! POP mail can also be read via Eduroam.</p>
<p>Leiden University is only accessible for students, staff members and guests of Leiden University via the ULCN account.</p>	<p>Eduroam is also accessible to students and staff members of other universities and universities of higher education via their Eduroam account (= the ULCN account for Leiden).</p>

How do I gain access to the wireless network?

Before your first attempt to connect to the wireless network, you must, as a Windows user, download the software which allows you to log in (this is a one-time-only operation). See below for detailed instructions on access via Leiden University and Eduroam.

Leiden University	Eduroam
Non-secure (unencrypted) connection	Secure (encrypted) connection
Apple Macintosh, Linux pc or PDA users can log in directly using their ULCN account after opening an Internet browser.	Connect to the Leiden University network (in Windows via Start – Connection, or via the Configuration screen). Open your web browser.
Connect to the Leiden University network (in Windows via Start – Connection, or via the Configuration screen).	You will now see the Leiden University Wireless Access page. Choose here the procedure for downloading/installing the Eduroam software (Secure W2 client) which is compatible with your device. In order to download the client, you must fill in your Eduroam/ULCN user name and password (no domain name) during the installation. After downloading the Eduroam software, you must restart your pc.

Important remarks

To prevent your pc from automatically starting up Leiden University instead of Eduroam the next time you log in, you can change the preferred order of network start-up in your network menu.

The university rules of conduct concerning computer use are applicable to the use of the wireless network facilities. These rules can be found at wireless.leidenuniv.nl.

Subsequent times when you start up the wireless network

Connect to Leiden University or Eduroam (usually this happens automatically).

Open your web browser.

Log in on the wireless network with your Eduroam/ULCN account (for Windows via the Clean Access Agent and for others via the Leiden University Wireless Access webpage) and you can get started.
