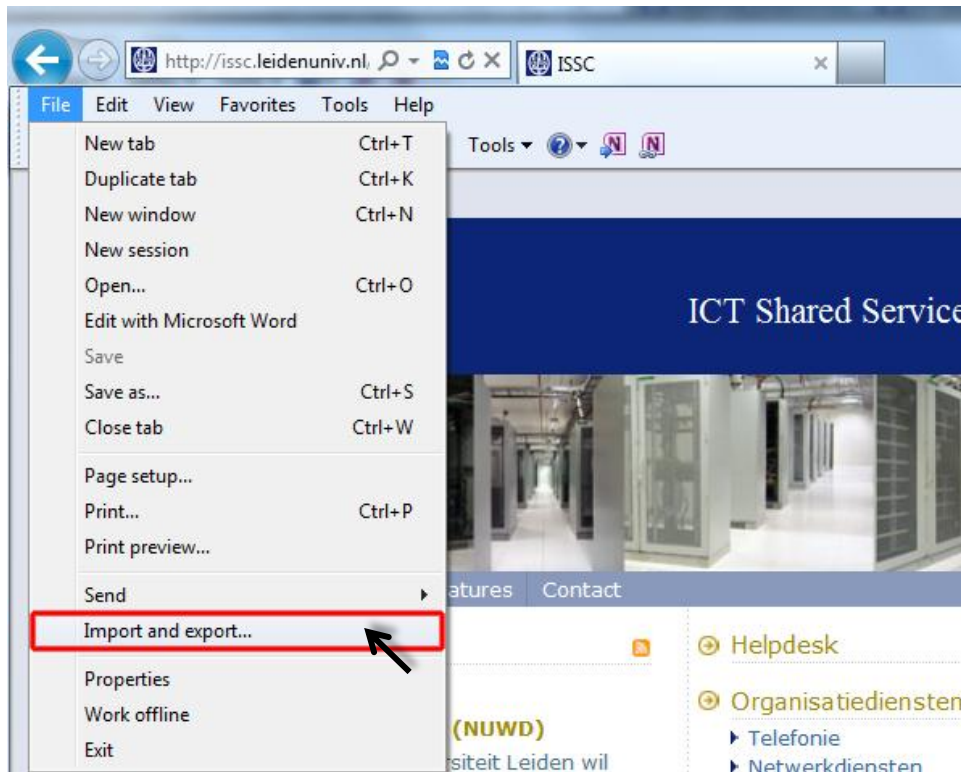

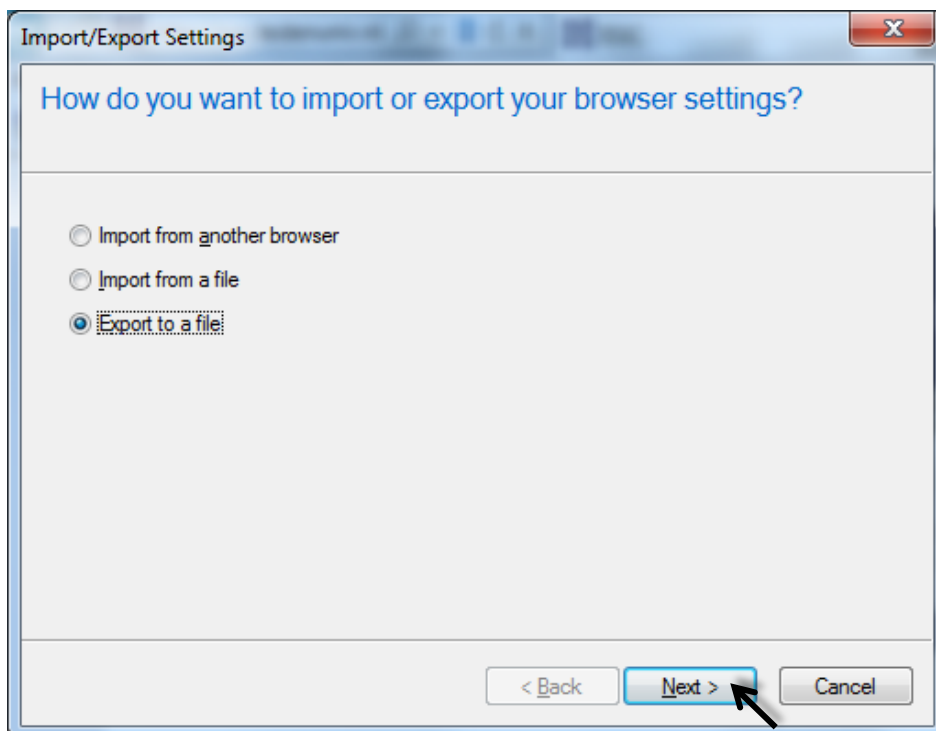
Exporting RSS Feeds

The example below shows you how to export your RSS feeds to a file in Internet Explorer 9.

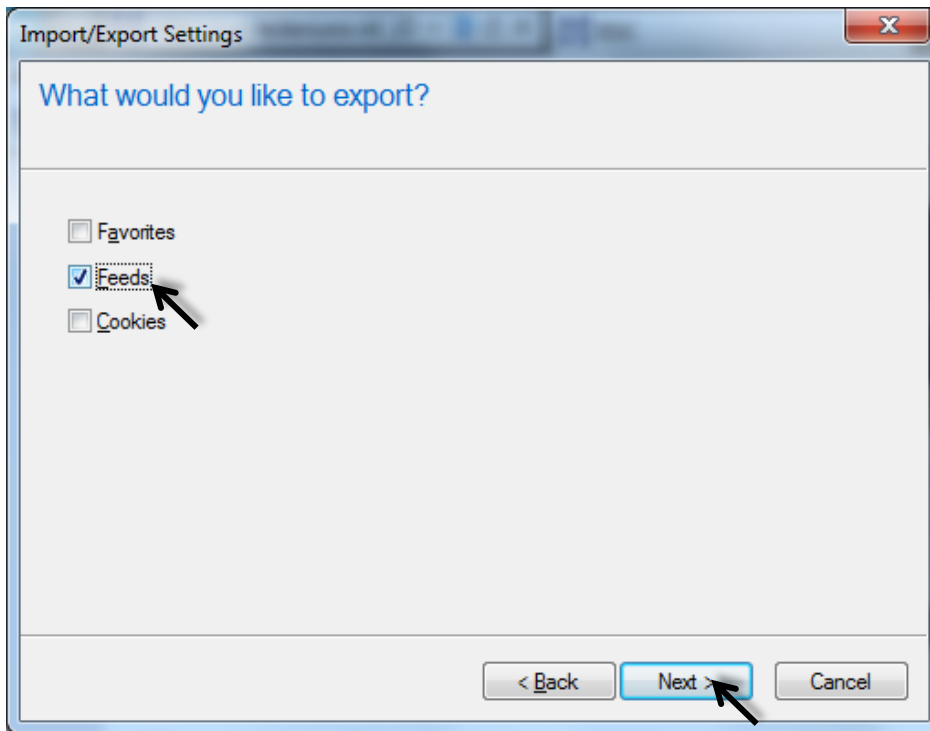
1) Select “**Import and export..**”



2) Select “**Export to a file**” and then “**Next**”

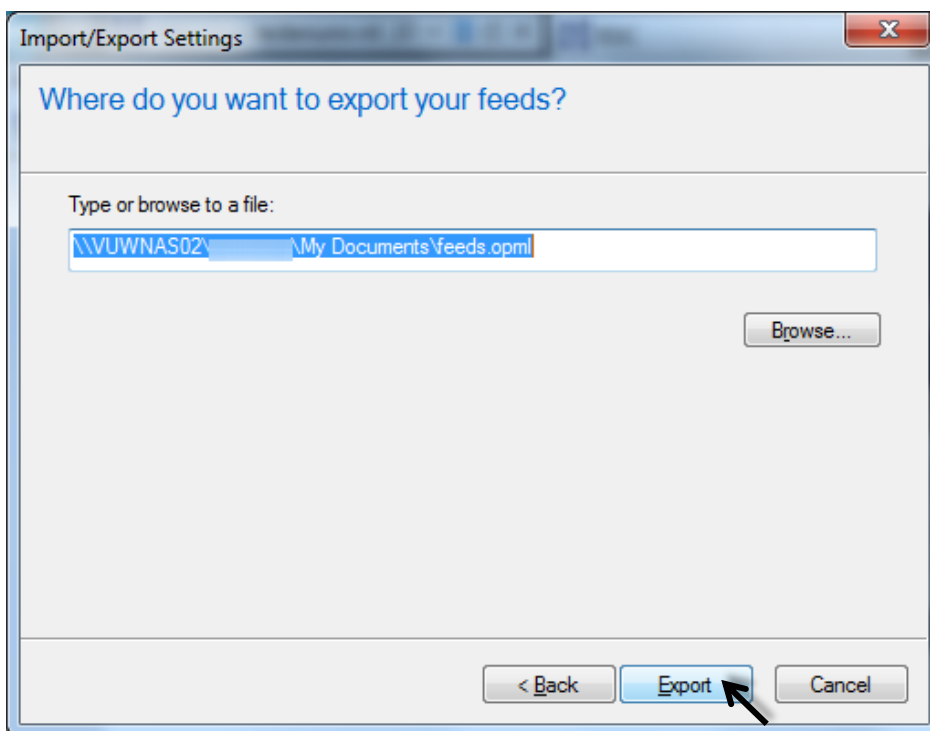


3) Select “Feeds” and then “Next”

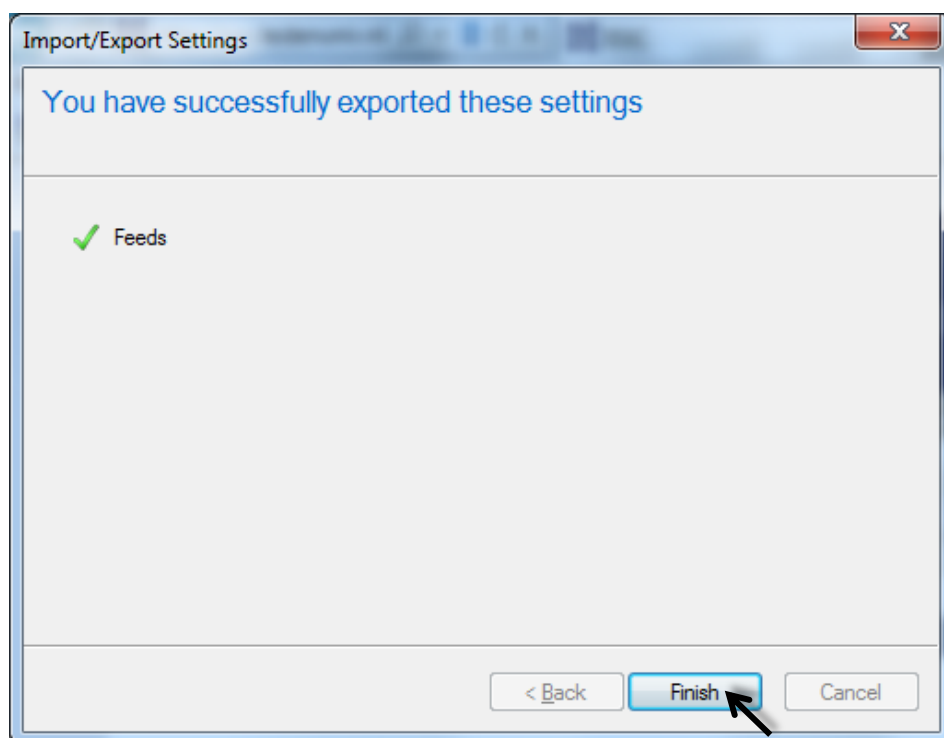


4) Select “Export”

*If you do not specify a location, Internet Explorer will save your RSS feeds in the My Documents folder. You can also use **Browse** so select a different location, for instance a USB stick.*

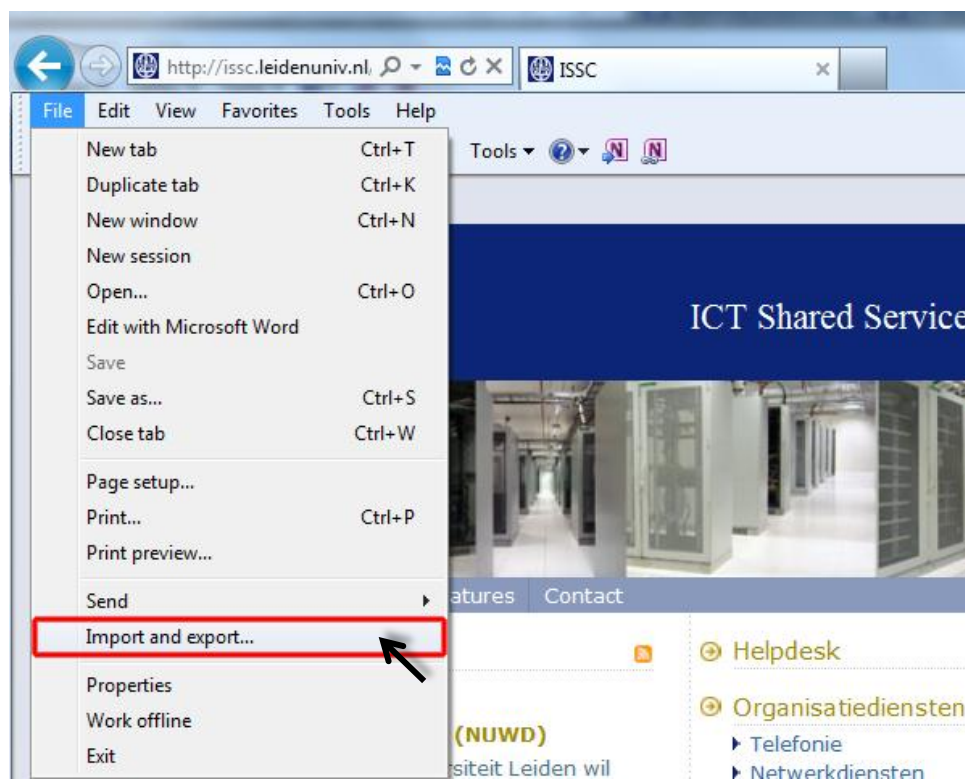


5) Select “**Finish**”

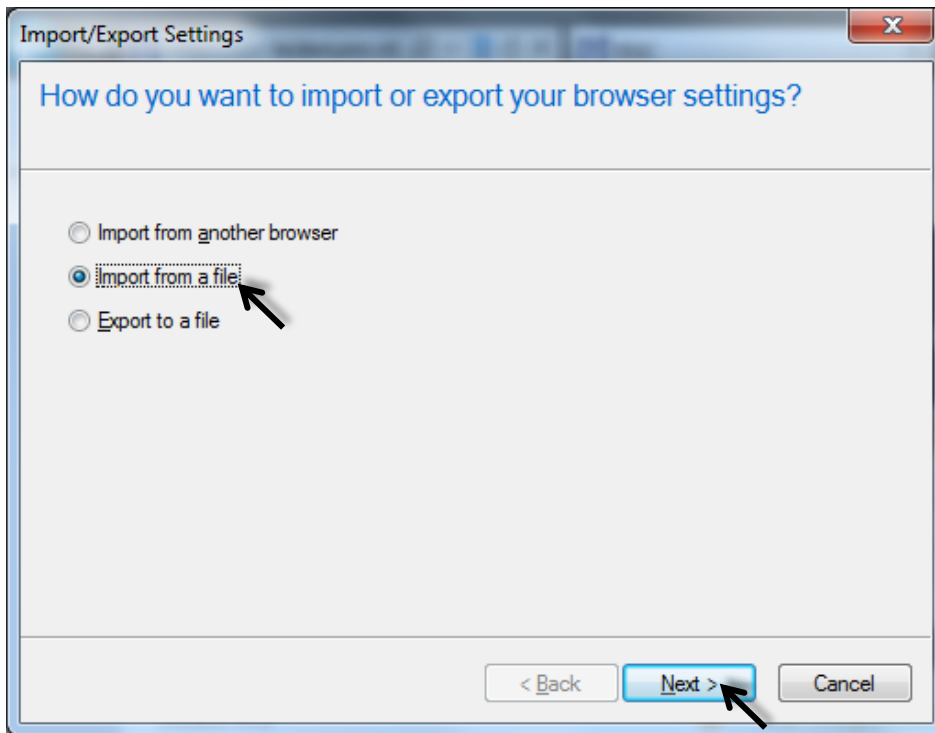


Importing RSS Feeds

1) Select “**Import and export..**”

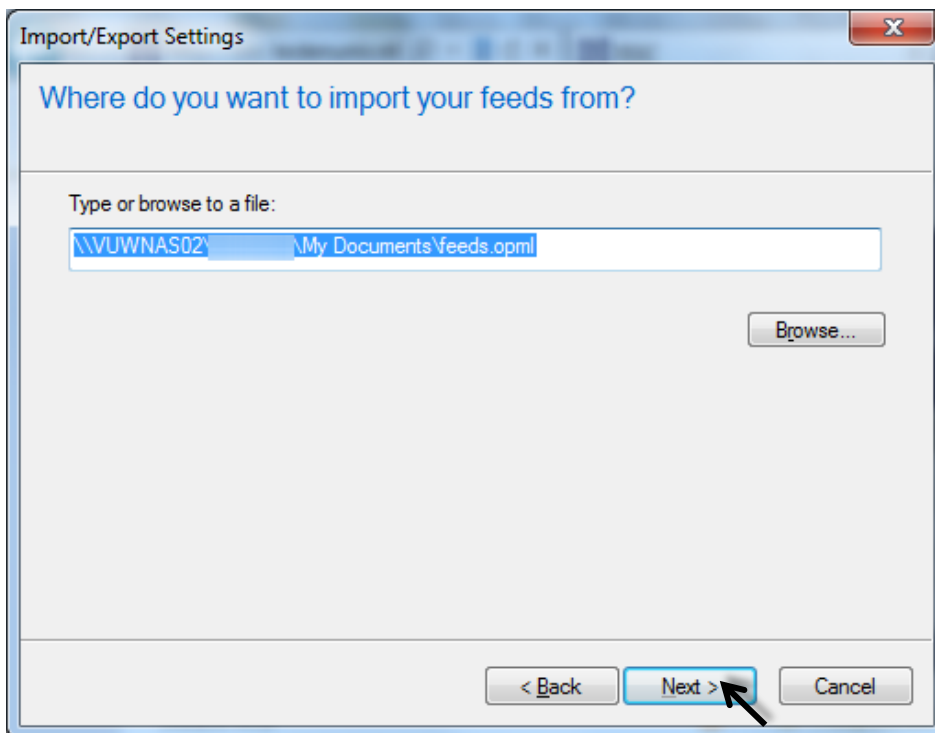


2) Select “**Import from a file**” and then “**Next**”

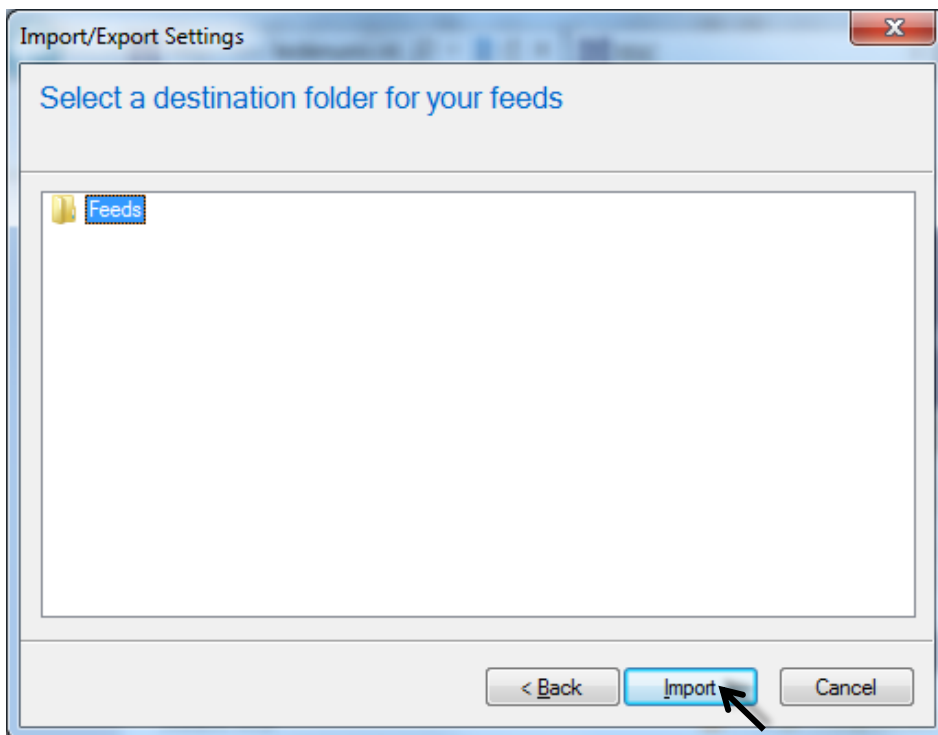


2) Select “**Import from a file**” and then “**Next**”
